Allen Heaton was the salutatorian of his Corning High School Class of 1945. He joined the U.S. Navy in 1945. Following discharge from the Navy he attended Iowa State University in Ames for two years. In 1950 he returned to Corning to work at the Bank of Brooks and Heaton Insurance Agency. Allen was involved in many church and community activities. He could always be counted on to lend a helping hand. Throughout his life he encouraged higher education but also felt it was important to give back to his community with time and talent.

The family hopes that this scholarship will help a CHS student further their education so that they may reach their goals in life and give back to their community.

Eligibility

- Involved in community and volunteer opportunities
- Involved in extra-curricular high school activities
- Maintained average or better high school grades

Amount

The amount of the scholarship is \$500 with the announcement of the Allen Heaton Scholarship award at the Corning High School graduation each year.

Selection Committee

The Corning Education Foundation and a member of the Heaton family will choose the recipient of this scholarship.

Disbursement

Payment of the award will be made after the student completes their first semester of college and submits a copy of the grades and registration for second semester classes to the Corning High School Counselor. If the student has maintained satisfactory grades and is enrolled for the second term, the High School Guidance Counselor will make authorization for payment to the Corning Education Foundation.

Application Deadline:

The applicant must submit a letter of application and resume to the Corning High School Guidance Counselor by April 24th.
