

Adams Community Chamber of Commerce \$250

The Adams Community Chamber of Commerce is granting a \$250 scholarship to a student considering a four-year program or a two year vocational-technical field. The Chamber takes pride in our youth and encourages involvement in the Adams community.

The scholarship is awarded on a 100 points system. A maximum number of 25 points can be awarded in each of 4 fields: High School Activities; Plans For Future Education; Citizenship/Leadership Involvement In The Community; and Chamber Activities.

The application should be in the form of a letter to the Adams Community Chamber of Commerce. It should include an outline of high school activities, major interests in school and plans for future education. The letter should also include a specific listing of community service activities in which you volunteered your time while in high school. Please give specific citizenship and leadership involvement in the community or organizations within the community. These should be beyond the normal activities of membership. Specific volunteer services for the Chamber of Commerce should also be included. Current annual activities include: Chamber Banquet, Easter Egg Hunt; May Beef Month; Survivor contest; Pedal Pull; Flight Breakfast; Craft Show; Lighted Christmas Parade; Children's Christmas Club. Other activities vary from year to year.

The application is due in the guidance office by April 29th.
