

**Adams County Cattlemen's Association Scholarship
\$1000**

1. Parent must be a member of the Adams Co. Cattlemen's Association
2. These scholarships are available to anyone enrolled for post-secondary schooling. Preference will be given to students enrolled in an agriculture-related field. Eligible applicants could include freshmen to graduate students.
3. Students are eligible to receive a scholarship from the Adams Co. Cattlemen 1 time only
4. Scholarship money will be made available upon request following enrollment in the second semester of a program.
5. The scholarship amount will be \$1000 each time given
6. Scholarship money must be used in the school year awarded or it will be forfeited
7. Application should be made to the guidance counselors of high schools in Corning, Orient, Lenox, Creston, Nodaway Valley, CAM and Villisca
8. The application should be in the form of a letter with information concerning your family, past high school/community activities, and leadership roles. Include a statement concerning intended college major and why you want to pursue that major. Applicants should also include future career goals and plans after graduation from college.

Must submit letter of application by APRIL 1st to the High School Counselor.
