

## **Adams County Speedway Scholarship**

### **Funded by Adams County Fair and Racing Association**

The Adams County Fair and Racing Association will be offering up to a \$500 scholarship(s) to a graduating senior(s). The scholarship will be made payable directly to the student and will be awarded after a copy of the first semester grades are turned in to the school counselor.

#### **Qualifications:**

Must be a graduating senior in Adams county and/or neighboring counties.  
Must have a grade point equal to or above average.

#### **Selection process:**

This scholarship is for any student with close ties to the Adams County Speedway, through the drivers, fans, or Adams County Fair & Racing Association. Award based on knowledge of the speedway evidenced in an essay, to include grade point average, community service, and educational goals.

#### **Application process:**

The application should be in the form of a letter. It should include information about your school and community activities and plans you have for your education and career goals. Essays must be: double spaced, 250-500 words.

#### **Deadline:**

Applications should be delivered to the Corning High School Guidance Counselor no later than April 30.

The scholarship recipient must attend a recognition ceremony at the Adams County Speedway on a designated race night in June.
