

Clark and Helen Carmichael Scholarship** \$500

This scholarship was established in memory of Clark and Helen Carmichael, lifelong residents of Adams County and graduates of Corning High School. Clark graduated in 1924 and Helen graduated in 1928. They were both advocates of lifelong learning and appreciated the merits of an education beyond high school.

Their son, Larry Carmichael, received his degree from Iowa State University in education and received further aviation training in the army. Larry was a pilot for TransWorld Airlines for 28 years.

Their daughter, Sally Carmichael-Hosfelt, received a bachelor's degree in Home Economics from Simpson College and a masters degree in deaf education from the University of Nebraska-Omaha, and has had a long career in deaf education in the Des Moines school system.

Criteria:

It is preferred that a candidate be a Corning High School senior or a graduating senior who resides in Adams County and that he/she also meet one of the following criteria:

1. Interest in aviation and obtaining a pilot's license and instrument rating in conjunction with a bachelor's degree;
2. Intent to receive a bachelor's degree in aviation, education, or agriculture and/or health care field. Intent to continue education at a community college/vocational school to qualify for an FAA (Federal Aviation Agency) Airframe and Power Plant license.

NOTE: All applicants will be considered.

ELGIBILITY:

Any Corning High School senior who meets the above criteria is eligible to apply for this scholarship. Submit a letter of application, resume, and the completed questionnaire (see next page).

COLLEGE PREFERENCE:

The following colleges will be given preference: Iowa State, Univ. of Iowa, UNI, Simpson, Northwest MO State, or enrollment in aviation at the University of ND, Central MO State, IA Western CC.

SELECTION METHOD:

The selection will be based on the applicant who best fulfills the criteria and preference categories. The selection will be made by a committee comprised of the Carmichael family.

AMOUNT:

The amount of the scholarship will be a minimum of \$200

PAYMENT

Payment will be made upon proof of registration for first semester classes. A copy of registration form should be submitted to the Corning High School Counselor. The check will be issued to the student and the college of attendance.

Deadline for submitting this scholarship to the counselor is April 24th.
