

Education Foundation Scholarship \$500 for 2 years (renewable for 2nd year)

The Corning Education Foundation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, scientific, and educational purposes. A goal of the foundation is to provide broader education services and opportunities to Corning Community Schools' students, staff, and residents of the geographical area of Corning Community Schools. It is the purpose of this scholarship to help students attain a technical certification or college degree. Corning Alumni and Corning residents have donated the funds for this scholarship.

Scholarship for 2009: The 2009 award will be in the amount of \$1000 to be disbursed as renewable in the amount of \$500 per year for 2 years. (NOTE: Technical programs, which are one year in length, will receive a one-time \$500 award at the semester of the certification year.)

The number of scholarships awarded will be determined by the number of applicants.

Eligibility: Any student attending any technical school, community college or four year college/university program
Must have a 2.00 grade point average at Corning High School

Application Procedure: The application should be in the form of a letter and resume'. Include

- Major interests in school
- Plans/goals for future in college and beyond
- Explain how this scholarship will help in attaining your goals
- Attach a resume

Selection Process: Selection will be made by members of the Education Foundation Board

Payment of Scholarship:

The recipient will be announced at graduation and payment will occur after the first semester of each year when copies of first semester grades and registration for 2nd semester is sent to Corning Guidance Office.
