

Jeremy Courtier Memorial Scholarship

My name is Bruce Courtier. In May 2005 my son Jeremy died in an automobile accident. He was 18 at the time. He was a "06" graduate at Nishna Valley, and had just finished his first year of college at IWCC. Jeremy was a kind, generous person that loved people and loved to help people. We are keeping his memory alive and carrying on his love through Scholarships given to deserving students in his name. This is the 3rd year that we are giving out scholarships. We have a poker run every year to raise funds for the scholarships. It is called the Jeremy Courtier Annual Memorial Scholarship Run. Last June (2008), our poker run came through Corning with a stop at J.O.s, and this year we have decided to give a scholarship in the amount of \$500.00 to a Corning senior. I think you will find that the application is very basic, and not demanding. That is the way we wanted it to be.

I have set up a committee that will review the applications, and make the final decision. The committee consists of 5 people that participated in the Memorial Ride. They will not know who the applicants are until I receive the final decision from the head of the committee.

I ask that you cooperate with me in insuring that no personal information (ie: names, or other identifying factors) be included in the application after the cover page. The cover page is going to be pulled and retained by me and replaced with an application number until the decision is made. I will not be involved in the decision making process as will none of the Courtier family.
