

# **Kenneth M Mallas Scholarship**

**\$200**

This scholarship honors Kenneth M. Mallas who was Superintendent of Corning Community Schools from 1972 through 1994. The scholarship is being established to assist a deserving Corning High School graduate to pursue a college degree. The scholarship will be awarded each year beginning with the Class of 1993. The amount of the Kenneth M. Mallas Scholarship will be \$200 each year.

## **BASIS OF SELECTION**

The scholarship award will be based on the following criteria:

- Financial Need
- Average grades in high school
- Character
- Citizenship
- Leadership
- Future Potential

## **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

Any Corning High School senior is eligible to apply who intends to pursue any type of post-secondary education. A student wishing to apply must submit a letter of application indicating high school and community activities, interests, and future plans.

## **METHOD OF SELECTION**

The selection of the recipient will be determined by a committee comprised of high school faculty. The winner shall be announced at graduation. Payment of the scholarship will occur after the first term in college. A copy of first term grades and enrollment form for second term must be submitted to the Corning High School Counselor.
