

Leta (Chafa) Norcross Scholarship

2 - \$200

This scholarship was established in honor of Leta (Chafa) Norcross. The amount of the scholarship will be determined by the interest that accumulates on the principal in the Leta (Chafa) Norcross fund each year. The amount of the two scholarships will be \$200.

Two scholarships will be given each year to students who are enrolled and graduate from Corning High School and who plans to attend Iowa State University. In the event that no students from a graduating class attend Iowa State, the selection committee shall decide if there are worthy applicants that are planning to attend other college in Iowa or to accumulate the funds for the following year.

The recipients shall be of good moral character and shall show some type of financial need to receive the scholarship.

The recipients of the scholarship will be announced at graduation each year. Payment of the award will be made after the student completes his/her first term in college and submits a copy of the first term grades to the high school guidance counselor. The counselor will then authorize the payment of the scholarship if the student has made satisfactory grades and is enrolled for the second term.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Any Corning senior who plans to attend Iowa State University or other Iowa colleges may apply. A letter acts as the application. Included in the letter should be an outline of activities, leadership roles, interests in life, future plans, and life-time goals. Please indicate your financial need for this scholarship,

SELECTION PROCESS

The selection will be made on the merits of the above criteria by a committee compose of school personnel. Approval of the chosen students must be made by the Chafa family.
