

Pheasants Forever Scholarship

The Adams County Pheasants Forever chapter will be offering a Scholarship to a graduating senior. The amount is still yet to be determined.

Qualifications:

Must be an Adams county resident or attending Corning High School.
Must have a grade point of 2.0 or better.

Selection Process:

Any high school senior who meets the above qualifications is eligible to apply who plan to attend any type of post-secondary institution, but preference may be given to a student pursuing a career in Conservation, Ag. Business, Ag Education or Wildlife biology.

Application Process:

The application should be made in the form of a letter. It should include information about your school and community activities and achievements, GPA, plans for your education, and career goals.

Award:

Payment of the scholarship will be made after successful completion of the first semester of post-secondary education and proof of enrollment in the second semester. Payment will be made directly to the student at the beginning of the second semester.

Deadline:

Applications should be delivered to the student's guidance counselor no later than April 3rd. Recipients will be determined by Adams County Pheasants Forever committee members and will be awarded during graduation or awards ceremony.
