

Wayne & Eileen Ryan Science Award

Wayne Ryan graduated from Corning High School in 1945. He was Dean for Research at the University of Nebraska Medical Center and Professor of Biochemistry/Obstetrics/Gynecology. He is a Professor Emeritus at present. He is the Founder of Streck Laboratories and presently serves as CEO and Chairman of the Corporation. Dr Ryan was inducted into the Omaha Business Hall of Fame in 2001.

Dr Wayne and Eileen Ryan established this scholarship to encourage Corning High School students to enroll in the upper level science/math courses and develop investigative problem solving skills needed to continue in the science field.

CRITERIA: the recipient must meet the following criteria:

1. Enrollment/completion of upper level science/math classes and academic excellence in high school
2. Community service, character, leadership, citizenship, and financial need
3. Intent to complete a Bachelor's Degree
4. Interest in pursuing a science related major in college

ELIGIBILITY: Any Corning High School senior who meets the above criteria is eligible to apply for this scholarship. The application should include the reasons why the applicant feels that he/she is qualified to receive this award.

SELECTION METHOD: The selection of the recipients of this scholarship will be based on those students who best fulfill the criteria.

METHOD OF PAYMENT: The scholarship will be paid after successful completion of 1st semester of study and submission of a copy of 1st semester grades to the guidance office. A check will be made to the student and the college of attendance
