Application materials and information about the scholarship will be distributed to all seniors by the senior high school counselor. The application written by the student must give the following information:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. An outline of activities and interest while in high school</li> <li>2. A statement of plans for future education</li> <li>3. A statement regarding lifetime goals and inspirations</li> <li>4. A statement of the students' qualifications for this scholarship</li> </ol> <p>Applications must be submitted by the date announced by the Corning Community Schools.</p> <p>A review committee of Corning faculty members will evaluate the applications and recommend 5 for further consideration. Final selection will be made the committee designated by the Corning Schools. This selections committee shall be composed of school personnel as well as individuals from the community.</p> <p>The winner of the scholarship is announced each year at the Corning High School graduation ceremony.</p> <p>The decision of the selection committee is final. The Corning Schools reserve the right to omit the award in any year in which there appears to be no applicant of adequate merit.</p>
